This Sunday we will read from the Gospel of Mark how Jesus sent his disciples out two by two to share the Gospel. He told them to take nothing for the journey but a walking stick and their sandals.

At the very least we will take money, some clothes, a cell phone, and either a Kindle, an iPad, or an iPod. We can't imagine living with all of these devices as they help us stay, "connected".

What if the point of traveling is being open to something new – new feelings, new experiences, of letting go of old baggage we really shouldn't be carrying around anyway. Isn't our vacation time intended to refresh us and help us let go of the stress of everyday living?

I'm not going to try and convince you to travel as lightly as Jesus suggests. When we go camping we are going to take two tents, sleeping bags, our favorite LL Bean travel mattresses, food and all sorts of other equipment and supplies to ensure our needs for comfort are met.

Travel. Travel lightly. Share the joy of the Gospel.
