## Council Corner

The Peace of the Lord Be With You,

The synod is holding its annual LEAD (Leadership, Education and Development) meeting on Saturday, March 8<sup>th</sup>. I have never been to a LEAD event before so I thought I would attend to see what I've missed. This looks to be an interesting day for worship, workshops and presentations. The good news is there are many workshops to choose from. The bad news is that I can only attend three. Oh, it's so hard to choose! After thinking about it for a while and considering that St. Mark's is undergoing redevelopment I chose three workshops that I think will be interesting and, hopefully, useful.

Following is a brief description of the workshops I will be attending. They seemed to be the most likely to address information we can use at St. Mark's as we continue in our redevelopment process.

**Welcoming and Affirming All the Members of your Congregation** - Not everyone in your congregation is the same, and we give thanks that God has made us that way. But everyone in your congregation deserves to feel welcomed, safe, accepted and an important part of the community. This workshop will help congregations recognize and support couples who wish to have life-long, monogamous, relationships. This workshop will also offer ideas and support for those who are honest and willing to be a place of welcome. This workshop will NOT be an opportunity to discuss positions on human sexuality in the church. If you attend this workshop, it is assumed you will work to be an inclusive congregation.

**Celebrating Mission** - Join in a conversation about mission, technology and the church today. We will be looking at a variety of ways we can enhance a congregation's outreach ministries.

**Between Sundays - Using Facebook and Websites to Engage Active Congregants and Seekers** - Social media and websites can be a powerful mission tool. This workshop will help you learn the best use of these technologies for your congregation.

I am particularly interested in the workshops covering how technology can be used effectively to support our mission. I'll let you know what I learned in the next Council Corner.
